FAQS

Is Nestlé Carnation Evaporated Milk high in sugar?

There are 3 g of sugar and 0 g of added sugar in 2 Tbsp (30 mL) of Nestlé Carnation Evaporated Milk. See the "Nutritional Value" for more information.

What is the difference between evaporated milk and sweetened condensed milk?

Evaporated milk and sweetened condensed milk are both shelf-stable canned milk products where approximately 60% of the water has been removed. The major difference is that sweetened condensed milk has added sugar, while evaporated milk does not.

Can an open container of Nestlé Carnation Evaporated Milk be stored and used later?

Yes. Remaining Nestlé Carnation Evaporated Milk may be covered and stored in a refrigerator for 1-2 days.
