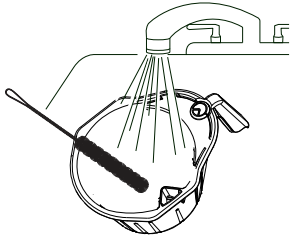




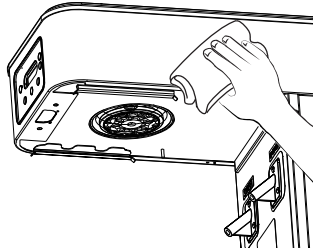
Daily Cleaning Instructions

Daily Cleaning - Brewer



STEP 1

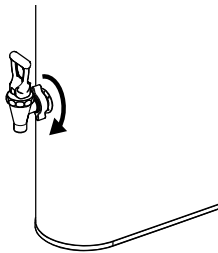
Once a day, clean and sanitize the brew funnel, funnel tip and screen assembly.



STEP 2

Wipe the sprayhead panel clean with a damp cloth. Wipe down the entire outside surface of the brewer with a clean damp cloth.

Daily Cleaning - Tea Dispenser



STEP 1

Turn the faucet wingnut in a clockwise direction and remove the faucet from the dispenser.



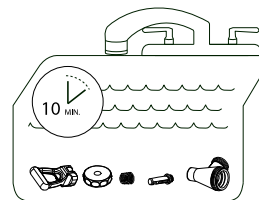
STEP 2

Unscrew the faucet cap from the faucet body and disassemble all faucet parts. Transfer these parts to a three compartment sink for cleaning with hot soapy water using a mild, non-citrus detergent.



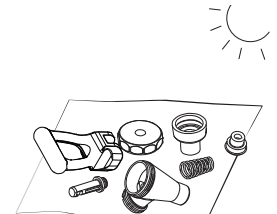
STEP 3

Use a bristle brush (BOM #00674.0000) to thoroughly scrub the faucet.



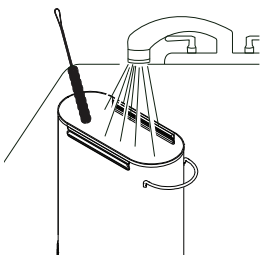
STEP 4

Allow the parts to soak in a non-chlorine sanitizing solution for a minimum of ten minutes.



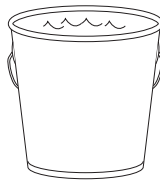
STEP 5

Remove the faucet parts from the sanitizer solution and rinse thoroughly. Allow parts to air dry overnight.



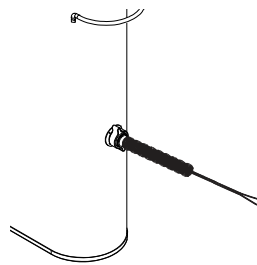
STEP 6

Thoroughly clean the entire inside surface of the dispenser and the faucet shank using a bristle brush (BOM#00674.0000) and a mild non-citrus detergent and water solution. Thoroughly rinse the dispenser with clean water.



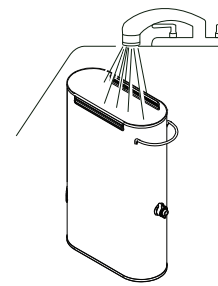
STEP 7

Prepare one quart of non-chlorine sanitizing solution in a clean bucket. Pour sanitizer solution into the dispenser.



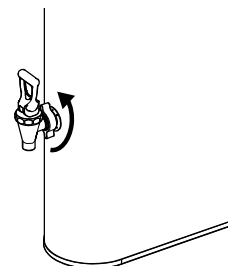
STEP 8

Pour a small amount of sanitizer solution into the faucet shank. Use a bristle brush (BOM #00674.0000) to clean all the way through the faucet shank. Repeat several times.



STEP 9

Empty the sanitizing solution from the dispenser. Thoroughly rinse the dispenser with clean water. Allow the dispenser to air dry overnight.



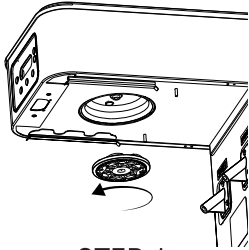
STEP 10

Assemble the faucet components and attach to the dispenser turning the wingnut counter clockwise.

DO NOT KEEP BREWED BEVERAGES OVERNIGHT

Weekly Cleaning Instructions

Weekly Cleaning - Brewer



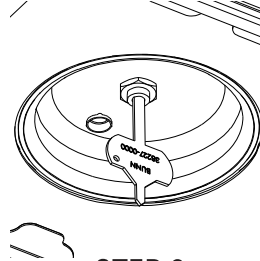
STEP 1

Once a week, remove the sprayhead by turning in a counter-clockwise direction.



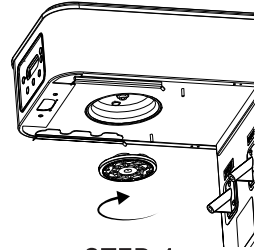
STEP 2

Disassemble and thoroughly rinse the sprayhead. The holes must be open and clear of any mineral deposits.



STEP 3

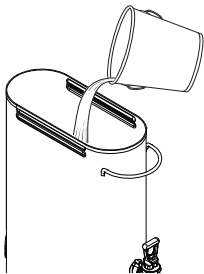
Use the long end of the sprayhead cleaning tool to clean the sprayhead outlet fitting.



STEP 4

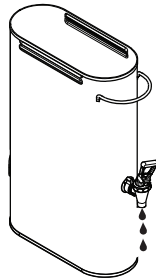
Re-install the sprayhead.

Weekly Cleaning - Tea Dispenser



STEP 1

Once a week, fill the dispenser with a non-chlorine sanitizing solution.

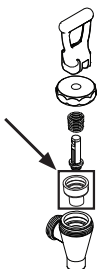


STEP 2

Draw a small amount (2 oz.) of sanitizing solution through the faucet. Allow the dispenser to soak overnight. The next morning, perform the daily cleaning procedures on the faucet and dispenser.

Monthly Cleaning Instructions

Monthly Cleaning - Tea Dispenser



STEP 1

Once a month, replace the faucet seat cup (BOM #00600.0001).



STEP 2

The faucet assembly (BOM #3260.0001) can be ordered for replacement.

CAUTION:

DO NOT submerge the server in water. Damage to internal components may result.
