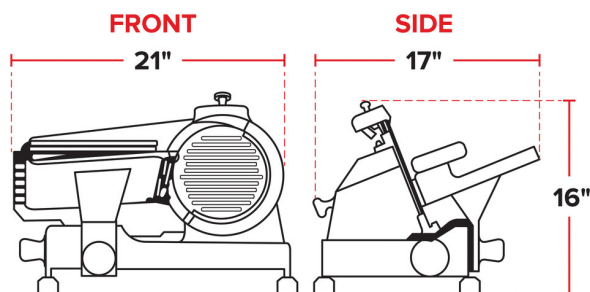

The Avantco 10" slicer is made of top quality aluminum for durability, and it comes with a built-in sharpening assembly. For easy cleaning, the meat carriage is removable, and it also has a fixed ring guard for safety. The slicer's stainless steel blade is belt-driven by a 1/4 hp motor.

This slicer rated for 2 hours use daily, and it is excellent for low-volume applications of less than 1 hour of slicing per day. It is not suitable for continuous heavy use, raw or frozen meat, or cheese.
